Infants and children may suffer serious emergencies in or near the home. These emergencies include respiratory arrest, choking and cardiac arrest. Victims are more likely to survive if you perform CPR and call 9-1-1 promptly.

If you want to know what to do in a life-threatening emergency involving an infant or child, this American Heart Association course in cardiopulmonary resuscitation can help you. With the knowledge and skills you will learn in this course designed for parents, grandparents, pool owners and babysitters, you can save the life of a child you love!

In this three-hour session, you will learn:

- Simple strategies to reduce the risk of sudden infant death syndrome (SIDS), choking and injuries in infants and children
- First aid for children, including how to care for bleeding, broken bones, seizures and burns

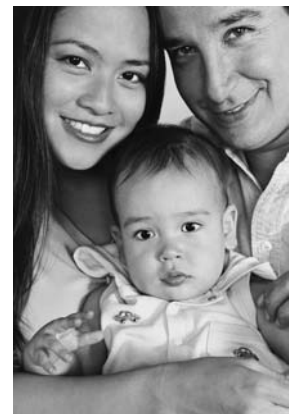
